



Faith Builder Verse:

Philippians 3:8

Daily Devotional Thought:

→Day 1: At family devotion, everybody
Needs an object in the house that you love but is not real?
Can this object talk? Can it eat? Can it Jump or run
or tell you secrets? Read Exodus 20:4. What happens
if we treat objects like they were God? How is God
different that your favorite object? Thank God that He
is alive and powerful and real!

→Day 2: An idol is an object or false god
that people worship and serve, hoping to find
happiness in their heart. In 1 Thessalonians 1:9-10
the people used to serve idols. What decision did they
make that changed their lives? We need to be careful
about what we think makes our hearts happy. God made
you so He knows what really makes your heart full of true
happiness. Pray as a family to seek God's Word and
not this world for True happiness. Trust God!

→Day 3: What are some idols that people served in
1 Thessalonians 1:9-10? They served Greek Gods
that they thought would make them beautiful, rich,
strong, smart, kind, fun, and important. Why do
think these things are important to people? Did you
know that everybody wants these things? One day
we all will desire to have this too. God has promised
that when we trust Jesus and follow Him, He fills our
hearts so full that every one of these desires will be met.
Read the FBV together. How important is Jesus to you?

→Day 4: 1 Thess. 1:9-10...2 words stick out that are very
important: Serve and Wait. How do you serve God as a
family? What does it mean to wait on Jesus to come back?
Revelation 22:7, 12, 20 "And behold, I am coming soon." If we
truly serve the True God, we have a promise that He will come get us.

→Day 5: Read the FBV & 1 Thessalonians
1:9-10... Pray for Turning Pointe and your family
to serve Jesus and wait on Him to come get us.
