



Memory Verse: Joshua 24:15

Daily Devotional Thought:

→Day 1: Read Joshua 24:1-14 out loud. It's lengthy, so share the reading if possible to keep everybody involved. What is Joshua reminding Israel about God? Talk about God the warrior who protects His people from the enemy. Search these verses and discover how God is the hero for those who believe and follow Him. (ex. Joshua 24:6...I brought your fathers out...)

→Day 2: God is a jealous God. That means that He only wants us to follow Him. It's important to know why God only wants us to love (worship) Him. Read Exodus 20:4-6. Because God loves us, His creation, so deeply, He does not want us involved in loving things more than Him. As a family decide if there may be "things", other than God, that you love (worship) more. Ask forgiveness if you find something and spend time honoring God together.

→Day 3: Knowing what God has done in the past, builds a trust in us of what God can do today! Do you believe that God can be trusted and followed? How about your whole family? Read Joshua 24:15 and discuss who you will follow as a family.

→Day 4: Do you trust God? Read Psalm 20:7 and worship God together by thanking Him for being stronger than armies and weapons.

→Day 5: Talk about 2 Timothy 1:7 together. Pray for your church, Your family, and Sunday worship. Discuss how your family worship time went.
